Let's Do It World is a non-governmental organisation that tackles environmental challenges related to the global mismanaged solid waste problem, by mobilising millions of positive-minded people to participate in coordinated local and global actions.

We have member organizations and representatives in more than 164 countries, who tackle the global waste crises. Our headquarters is based in Tallinn.

World Cleanup Day, led by the global movement of Let's Do It World, unites 191 countries and millions of people across the world to clean up the planet – in just one day, every September.

MAIN TASKS OF THE VOLUNTEER

Communication and **Marketing** Team or Regional team will be the main teams for volunteer. The aim of these teams is to inspire the network and the global society to clean up their countries from illegal waste in just one day. The other aim is to support the network with communication and marketing guidelines, promotion materials, know-how, events and campaigns. These are the teams where the volunteer can find different ways to help with her/his knowledge, experience and cultural background.

PROFILE OF THE VOLUNTEER

We are looking for the volunteer who will share the dream of the waste-free world and likes communication in different forms.

Accommodation:

The accommodation costs are covered. The volunteer will live in a shared flat or dormitory equipped with all the necessary utilities for comfortable living.

Allowance:

Each month volunteers receive a total of 270€ pocket and food money.

Transport:

The transportation from home country to Estonia and back will be covered according to the distance calculator of Erasmus+ program: https://ec.europa.eu/programmes/erasmus-plus/resources/distance-calculator_en

Visa costs are covered.

The local transport card will be provided

Insurance:

The volunteer will have Cigna Health insurance.



Language support:

The volunteer will have access to Online Language Support to learn Estonian.

Volunteer's training cycle:

The volunteer will have on-arrival and mid-term training provided by the Estonian National Agency.

General support:

The coordinator of the project is MTÜ Noored Ühiskonna Heaks.

The volunteer will have a mentor to help with any issue and support the learning process.

Meetings with all of the volunteers and coordinators will take place in different parts of Estonia to evaluate the progress of the volunteering projects, set goals, socialize and discover new locations in Estonia.

Extra activities:

In addition to the work at the hosting organization, the volunteers will take part in different events and fairs to promote European Solidarity Corps and the Erasmus+ programme. They also have an opportunity to create their own initiative project.

Candidates must be aged 18-30 from European Programme and Partner countries of Erasmus+
